Positive Behavior Interventions & Support (PBIS) is a program that:

- Teaches schoolwide expectations for every area
- Focuses on positive interactions and verbiage
- Enacts higher-leverage strategies for students in need of intervention
- Uses tangible incentives to encourage desired behaviors
- Collects and examines data to inform staff action

ENVoY Nonverbal Classroom Management is a program that teaches specific strategies for:

- Getting student attention
- Delivering instruction
- Transitioning to seatwork
- Managing seatwork

Similarities
Focus on influence, not power
Focus on the positive
Use a discrete set of principles
Used schoolwide

Differences: PBIS	Differences: ENVoY
General set of behaviors	Specific set of skills
Set school rules (Be respectful, etc)	7 Gems + refinements
Teach to all students	Teach the adults
No specific skills for getting student attention	Specific skills for getting student attention
No specific skills for delivering instruction	Specific skills for delivering instruction focusing on hands raised/not raised
No specific skills for transitioning to seatwork	Use of exit directions, MITS
No specific skills for student management during seatwork	Specific skills for student management during seatwork
